K-VA-T Food Stores, Inc. is a supermarket chain operating in three states under the name Food City and Super Dollar. This privately held company has grown over the years by expansion and acquisition. With stores in southeastern Kentucky, southwest Virginia and northeast Tennessee, K-VA-T is an acronym of its trade area: Kentucky, Virginia and Tennessee. The 100 plus-store chain serves a current trade area population of over 2.5 million people.

K-VA-T Food Stores is replacing proprietary DVR's and analog cameras with exacqVision video management software (VMS) running on industry standard HP ProLiant servers. K-VA-T is using 1.3 to 5 megapixel cameras to increase video resolution and improve image quality over the previous analog system. exacqVision was also integrated with MICROS-Retail XBR Loss Prevention software, which is an exception-based loss prevention solution that lets you quickly and easily identify, track, and respond to store events. Suspicious transactions can be identified and video can be retrieved from the exacqVision server software.

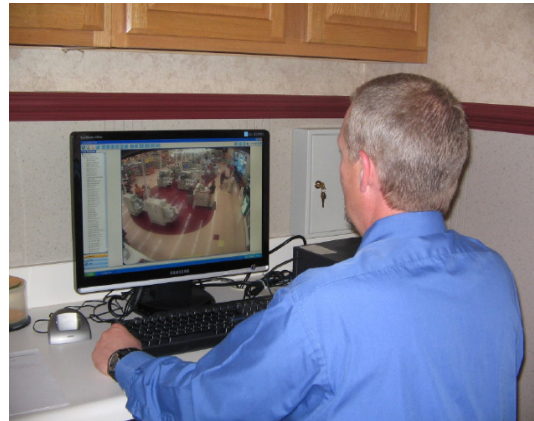

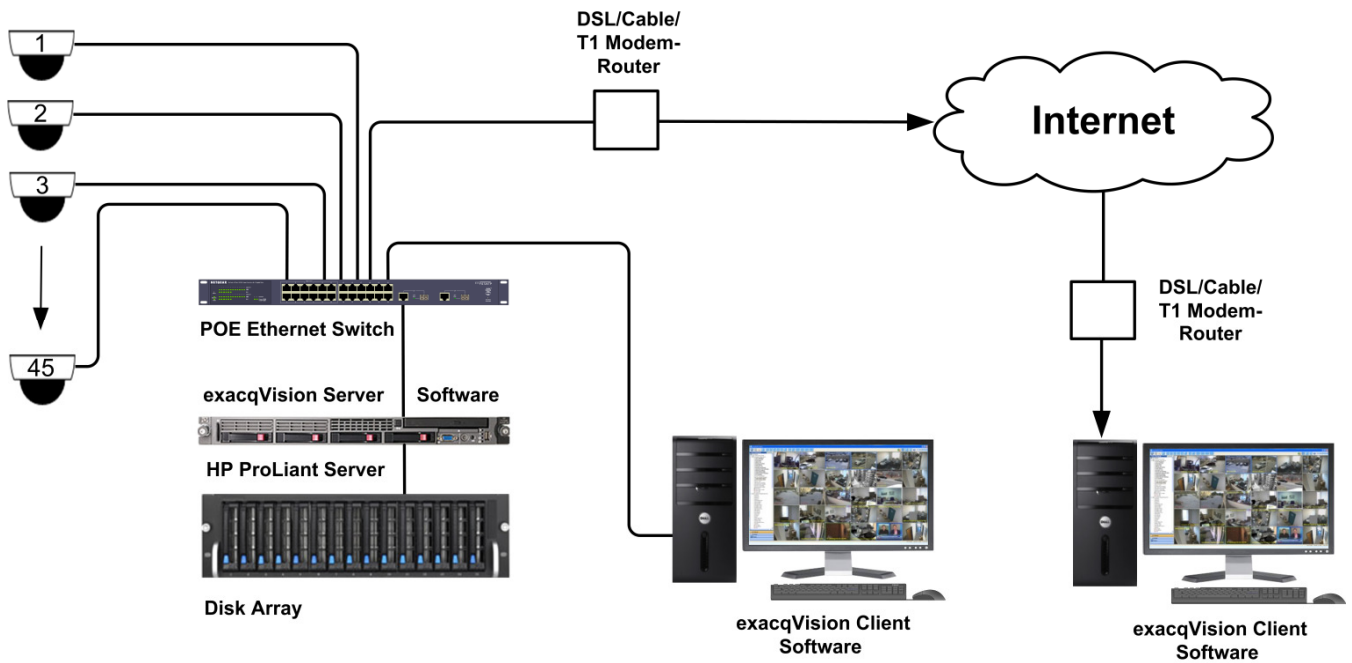
